SUBJECT: REQUEST FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION CONCERNING RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS LICENSE AMENDMENT REQUEST DATED NOVEMBER 16, 1998 (DOCKET NO. 030-28978, MAIL CONTROL NO. 258187)

Dear Mr. Dyer:

This refers to your license amendment request dated November 16, 1998, for License No. 47-24813-01. Please find below the areas that need to be clarified with additional information. The following information is needed to complete our review of your amendment request:

- A. The documentation for Mr. Ron McAhron as Radiation Safety Officer (RSO) did not include any certification of his attendance at a vendor or manufacturer training course sufficient to meet the requirements in Criteria, Section 8.8, Item 7 "Individuals Responsible for Radiation Safety Program and Their Experience - Radiation Safety Officer" in NUREG-1556, Volume 1, May 1997, "Consolidated Guidance about Materials Licenses, Program-Specific Guidance about Portable Gauge Licenses" (enclosed).

Alternatively, it would be acceptable for a vendor-trained gauge user to be nominated as the RSO. Please ensure that Mr. McAhron meets the requirements prior to assuming the duties of the RSO.

Our review of your amendment request will continue upon receipt of the above requested information. Please provide two copies of your reply and refer to Mail Control No. 258187.
