RE Decommissioning Plan/License Amendment Request: License 39-19727-01

Dear Mr. Parker:

Enclosed is the referenced Decommissioning Plan (DP). A check for the appropriate license amendment fee is in process and will be forwarded in approximately 10 days. INS respectfully requests expedited review, if possible, as limited decommissioning activities are planned to commence in early April.

As I understand our conversation of earlier today, limited decommissioning activities are permitted prior to issuance of the decommissioning amendment. Limited activities include items routinely performed under the authorizations of the effective license such as surveys, decontamination, and activities that are related to maintenance, installation, or removal of equipment and systems that were conducted during operational periods. Activities that will not be conducted until final review and approval of the DP include concrete scabbling or removal, major structural demolition, or the filling of any pits, trough, or remediated areas. I also wanted to clearly state that the NRC will be contacted at least 1 week in advance in order to provide at least a 2 regular work day window to perform confirmatory measurements and collect samples prior to the filling of the trough, pit and any excavated areas.

The site RSO's (Ed Hinchman) position with INS was terminated on good terms effective today. Please consider my resume for the position of RSO during the remaining duration of the license. If you have any questions regarding the DP or any other matter regarding this facility, please do not hesitate to contact me at extension 24.
