
Dear Mr. Lesser:

As I spoke to you yesterday over the phone, my calibration sources of Cesium and Cobalt were transferred to Meritus TLS of Roanoke, Virginia. They have a mobile nuclear medicine unit that comes to the Beckley area and they have picked up the above sources from my premises.

For the completion of the NRC Form 314, I have to indicate my license expiration date. Although my license was renewed for 5 more years after it's expiration on February 28th, 1997, I do not have this renewed license in my file. Without that knowledge I cannot put an accurate license expiration date for the completion of the Form 314. I may also need to show that I have a valid license at the time of the transfer of the above sources. For accuracy sake, could you please help me by sending the renewed license although I do not wish to continue this license as I have previously stated. Once you receive the completed Form 314 and the related information, you can cancel this license.

Yesterday I also had an opportunity to talk with Mike Fuller. However I have not discussed with him of the above technical problem. As you have advised, on Mr Fuller's return to the office please assist me to complete the termination of my NRC license
