
Gentlemen:

Enclosed is Amendment No. 18 to License No. 45-11589-02 issued in response to your license renewal application dated April 10, 1995. Revisions to your license are printed in **BOLD** typeface. Please review this document carefully and be sure that you understand all of its provisions. In particular, we call your attention to Condition No. 15 of the license, which further restricts your possession limits specified in Condition No. 8 of the license. Enclosed also are Regulatory Guides 3.65 and 3.66 which provide guidance on facility decommissioning and associated financial assurance regarding the restriction imposed by License Condition No. 15.

Also, please note that your proposed procedure in Item 3 of your letter dated June 26, 1995 may not necessarily ensure compliance with 10 CFR 20.1501. Specifically, the first paragraph in Item 3 indicates that, whenever an exhaust ventilation system is energized, air sampling equipment draws air at 30 liters per minute.... However, Item 2 indicates that exhaust flow rates may vary from 33.75 to 150 lbm/min. This implies that the sampling may not be isokinetic and may result in inadequate sample collection. Furthermore, the procedure is silent with respect to the effect of filter buildup on the total measured airflow. No response regarding these issues is required at this time. However, please be advised that the adequacy of your survey techniques may be evaluated for compliance with regulatory requirements during future inspections.

MATERIALS LICENSE

Amendment No. 18

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-43P), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below; to use such material for the purpose(s) and at the place(s) designated below; to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). 12. Licensed material shall be used by, or under the supervision of, George M. Smith or C. Lee Trent.
13. Licensed material shall not be used in or on human beings or in products distributed to the public.
14. The licensee shall maintain records of information important to safe and effective decommissioning at the location specified in Condition 2 in accordance with the provisions of 10 CFR 30.35(g) until this license is terminated by the Commission.
15. In addition to the possession limits in Condition 8, the licensee shall further restrict the possession of licensed material to quantities below the minimum limit specified in 10 CFR 30.35(d) for establishing decommissioning financial assurance.
