

MATERIALS LICENSE

Amendment No. 1

Pursuant to the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, the Energy Reorganization Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-438), and Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Chapter I, Parts 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 39, 40, and 70, and in reliance on statements and representations heretofore made by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the licensee to receive, acquire, possess, and transfer byproduct, source, and special nuclear material designated below, to use such material for the purposes, and at the place(s) designated below, to deliver or transfer such material to persons authorized to receive it in accordance with the regulations of the applicable Part(s). This license shall be deemed to contain the conditions specified in Section 143 of the Atomic Energy Act of 1954, as amended, and is subject to all applicable rules, regulations, and orders of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission now or hereafter in effect and to any conditions specified below.

10. This license does not authorize the use or storage of licensed material at St. Lukes Episcopal Hospital.
11. Radiation Safety Officer: Edgardo Ortiz, Jr., M.D.
12. Licensed material shall be stored by or under the supervision of Edgardo Ortiz, Jr., M.D.
13. Sealed sources containing licensed material shall not be opened or removed from the source holder by the licensee.

CONDITIONS

14. The eye applicator device shall have a locked container designed to prevent unauthorized or accidental removal of the sealed source from its shielded position. The eye applicator must be locked in its storage container when in transport, storage or when not under the direct surveillance of an authorized user.
15. The licensee shall maintain records of information important to safe and effective decommissioning at location specified in Condition 10 pursuant to the provision of 10 CFR 30.35(g) until this license is terminated by the Commission.
16. A. The licensee may not possess and use materials authorized in Items 6, 7, and 8, until: 1) the licensee has constructed facilities and obtained the equipment described in the application and supporting documentation; and 2) the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission, Region II, ATTN: Chief, Nuclear Materials Inspection Section, 101 Marietta Street, Suite 2900, Atlanta, GA 30323, has been notified in writing that activities authorized by the license will be initiated.
- B. In accordance with the requirements set forth in 10 CFR 30.36(b), the licensee shall promptly notify the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, in writing of a decision not to complete the facility, acquire equipment, or possess and use authorized material.
17. Except as specifically provided otherwise in this license, the licensee shall conduct its program in accordance with the statements, representations, and procedures contained in the documents, including any enclosures, listed below, except for minor changes in the medical use radiation safety procedures as provided in 10 CFR 35.31. The Nuclear Regulatory Commission's regulations shall govern unless the statements, representations, and procedures in the licensee's application and correspondence are more restrictive than the regulations.
