Dear Ms. Halm:

On behalf of Communications Instruments, Inc., we are writing to inform you of a change in the ownership and operational control of the equipment subject to the referenced license. The Transferee is purchasing a portion of the assets of Genicom Corporation, and will continue to operate the business utilizing the equipment at its current location. The expected date of the transfer of the equipment is November __, 1997. Accordingly, we request transfer of the subject license to Communications Instruments, Inc., and we request that this letter serve as the Transferor's and Transferee's application for transfer and license name change.

There will be no change in the personnel having control over the licensed activities or of the responsible personnel as named in the license. Genicom does not plan to remain in non-licensed business without the license.

The transaction will involve a sale of a portion of the assets of Genicom Corporation and Genicom's relays manufacturing business. No other changes in organization are anticipated. There will be no change in the use, possession, location or storage of the licensed material. Nor will there be changes in organization, location, facilities, equipment, procedures, or personnel that would necessitate a license amendment. Genicom Corporation and the Transferee agree to the change in ownership and control of the licensed material and all conditions surrounding this transfer.

All surveillance items and records will be current on November __, and will be transferred to the Transferee as of that date. All records concerning decommissioning of the facility, public dose, and waste disposal by release to sewers, incineration, radioactive material spills, and on site burials have been transferred to the Transferee.

There is presently no nuclear contamination documented at the facility. However, if nuclear contamination is found, as between the licensee and NRC, the Transferee assumes responsibility. Any cleanup required at the time of the transfer will be the responsibility of Genicom. The Transferee is aware of all open inspection items and, as between the licensee and NRC, accepts responsibility for any open inspection items and any resulting enforcement actions. In addition, the Transferee will abide by all constraints, conditions, requirements, representations, and commitments as set forth in the existing license. The Transferee will abide by all commitments previously made by Genicom Corporation to NRC.


